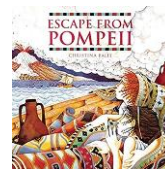

Use prepositions to describe this modern picture of Pompeii.



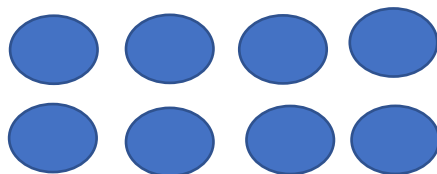

Challenge 2: Put the numbers you made in order from largest to smallest.

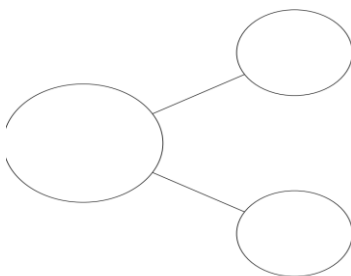
